Health PEI - Retroactive Pay

Members of the Local employed by Health PEI should have received their retroactive pay by now. There would have been increases effective of 1% on April 1, 2018, 1% on October 1, 2018 and 1.25% on April 1, 2019. Members should ensure that they received the proper amounts. This includes IUOE casuals who worked during these periods.

OT/PT wages

The Local recently went to interest arbitration over the OT/PT wages. As stated in the Ratification package, this was the only outstanding matter and the Parties agreed to refer the matter to arbitration before Bruce Outhouse. This included retention and recruitment, classification and wage compression issues. What was originally scheduled as a one-day hearing, turned into a two-day hearing. We are now awaiting the arbitrator's decision.

Canadian Conference

IUOE local 942 hosted the annual Canadian Conference. We had delegates and guests from Locals all across Canada and the US come to Charlottetown. The General President and a number of staff from the international headquarters in Washington were also in attendance. The Conference was a great success.
