International Overdose Awareness Day is August 31

International Overdose Awareness Day is a global event to raise awareness of overdose and to reduce the stigma. Overdose can occur with any medication. Opioid overdose is particularly dangerous because it affects breathing.

Signs of opioid overdose includes:

- Slow, weak or no breathing
- Blue lips/nails
- Dizziness or confusion
- Unable to wake up or difficulty staying awake
- Choking, gurgling, or snoring sounds

Opioid Overdoses: What To Do (fact sheet)

You may have heard of Naloxone. It's medication that can temporarily reverse the effects of an opioid overdose which provides time for medical help to arrive. You can find out more <u>here</u>.

You may not know that Naloxone kits are available without a prescription to anyone who may be at risk of overdose or who is likely to encounter one.

Our pharmacists provide assistance beyond minor illnesses. For example, if you:


- Have diabetes, we can work with you to optimize your management by creating a personalized care plan and establishing a regular follow up schedule.


